

# Summa Rehab Hospital Acute Rehabilitation Diagnosis Triggers

## Admission Guidelines by Diagnosis

- Stroke/CVA – all levels with residual deficits
- Spinal Cord Injury
- Congenital deformity
- Amputation – pre-prosthetic and prosthetic
- Bilateral knee replacement
- Multiple Trauma
- Fracture of femur
- Brain Injury – traumatic, post-surgical, anoxic, post-infectious, toxic, metabolic and alcoholic encephalopathies
- Neurological disorders – Multiple Sclerosis, Guillain-Barre Syndrome, Polyneuropathy, Demyelinating Diseases, Poliomyelitis (Post-Polio Syndrome), Myasthenia Gravis, Muscular Dystrophy, Parkinson's Disease – new diagnosis, exacerbation or change in function
- Burns
- Comorbid conditions that cause significant decline but are not the primary diagnosis – elevated body mass index (above 50), underlying history of neurological disorders
- Post-op neurosurgery – neoplasm, brain/spine tumor, meningioma, hydrocephalus, residual neurological deficits
- Post-op laminectomy – lower extremity weakness, bowel and bladder problems
- Medically complex – cardiopulmonary disease (pneumonia, CHF) or surgery (CABG) with or without complications, including weaned ventilator patients
- Steroid myopathy
- Alcoholic myopathy
- Uremic myopathy

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We admit patients from Acute Hospitals, Skilled Nursing and from Home – call Summa Rehab Hospital's Admissions Department for specific details.



## Additional Admission Guidelines

- Ability to tolerate an intensive rehabilitation program consisting of 15 therapy hours per week
- Patient requires two or more therapy services
- Potential to return to Self-care, Independence or Home with Assistance
- Medical Supervision by a Physician
- Need for 24-hour rehab nursing care - balance, bowel and bladder, neurological conditions, pain management, skin management, safety issues, and chronic disease management

- History and physical
- Physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech pathology notes
- Current labs, CT scans, MRI results
